BIOGRAPHICAL DESCRIPTION

The Wilds Christian Association, Inc., is a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization. We are designated as an eleemosynary corporation organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina. As a corporation, we are also domesticated in North Carolina and New Hampshire, the locations of our campsites. We are an independent, nondenominational, nonprofit organization averaging over 20,000 campers per year.

The North Carolina location, near Brevard, known as The Wilds, consists of over 1,000 acres and is utilized for camps, conferences, and retreats on a year-round basis. Over 500,000 campers have attended since the first youth camp in August 1969. During the summer of 2015, we served over 9,000 youth campers, 450 family campers, and 1,300 adult sponsors, for a total of over 10,800 individuals. The fall and spring seasons are dominated by marriage conferences, school and church retreats, high school senior trips and leadership training, ladies' retreats, senior citizens retreats, and specialized conferences (such as music, pastors, etc.). During this non-summer season, we annually serve more than 10,000 campers of all ages. We employ 64 full-time staff members at this location and have an additional 260 college students, young adults, and teachers on staff for the summer season.

Present strong demand for our particular approach to summer youth camping indicates that our market will continue to support the nearly full capacity operation that we have had for several years. Capital

improvements in excess of \$300,000 were made during the last fiscal year. The organization has no indebtedness.

In 2009 The Wilds of New England began ministry at our campsite in Deering, New Hampshire. In this peaceful, rural setting we have experienced good growth in attendance at our summer camps as well as in our limited fall schedule programs. We anticipate a continuing steady growth and expansion of the ministry at this New England location. We employ 5 full-time staff members as well as a few part-time employees at this location. During the summer camping season, we hire additional college-age young adults.

CampsAbroad, the missions arm of The Wilds, has been established in order to assist others in the formation and operation of Christian camp ministries around the world.

The administrative headquarters is located in Taylors, South Carolina, and consists of 9 full-time and 3 part-time employees. All promotion, public relations, fundraising, registrations, publications, shipping, and corporate business are transacted through this office.

Independent corporate auditors are Martin, Smith, and Company.
