

# SCRIPTURE MEMORY PASSAGES

## Passage 1: Psalm 19:7-14

<sup>7</sup> The law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple. <sup>8</sup> The statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes. <sup>9</sup> The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether. <sup>10</sup> More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. <sup>11</sup> Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward. <sup>12</sup> Who can understand his errors? cleanse thou me from secret faults. <sup>13</sup> Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression. <sup>14</sup> Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord, my strength, and my redeemer.

## Passage 2: Psalm 119:103-105, 130

<sup>103</sup> How sweet are Thy words unto my taste! yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth! <sup>104</sup> Through Thy precepts I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way. <sup>105</sup> Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path. <sup>130</sup> The entrance of Thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.

## Passage 3: 2 Timothy 3:16-17

<sup>16</sup> All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: <sup>17</sup> That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

## Passage 4: Titus 2:11-12

<sup>11</sup> For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, <sup>12</sup> Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;

## Passage 5: Isaiah 55:8-11

<sup>8</sup> For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways, saith the Lord. <sup>9</sup> For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts. <sup>10</sup> For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: <sup>11</sup> So shall My Word be that goeth forth out of My mouth: it shall not return unto Me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

## Passage 6: 1 Corinthians 2:10-11

<sup>10</sup> But God hath revealed them unto us by His Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. <sup>11</sup> For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

## Passage 7: Hebrews 4:12

<sup>12</sup> For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

## Passage 8: Proverbs 24:13-14

<sup>13</sup> My son, eat thou honey, because it is good; and the honeycomb, which is sweet to thy taste: <sup>14</sup> So shall the knowledge of wisdom be unto thy soul: when thou hast found it, then there shall be a reward, and thy expectation shall not be cut off.

Rules:

1. Passages must be said in order.
2. Passages are not cumulative.
3. 100 point bonus when everyone in the cabin (including the counselor) recites one passage.
4. 100 point bonus for each camper who recites ALL the passages.
